Members are responsible for turning in their Guest's Handicap Index and Age by this date.

## Format

The Tournament will consist of five 9-hole matches. Rounds will be played in a variety of formats (best ball, modified alternate shot, shamble, scramble, and combined net). The tournament will be flighted with each flight playing a round robin against all other teams in the flight. Format for all rounds will be Match Play. Winning the match will be worth 5 points, ties worth 3 points, and a loss worth 1 point. The entirety of each 9-hole match will be played and the hole-to-hole results recorded to be used in the case of a tie. The team with the most holes won over the weekend will advance.

Winning teams in each flight will automatically advance to the Championship Shoot-Out. Runner-ups in each flight will compete in a 1-hole playoff with two teams advancing to the Shoot-Out. In the event of a tie for the flight winners or flight runner-up there will be a chip-off to determine which team will advance.

Format for the playoff and Championship Shoot-out will be True Alternate Shot. The playoff will be played on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole. The Shoot-Out will be played on holes 15, 16, 17, & 18. The number of teams eliminated on each hole will be determined by how many teams are in the Shoot-Out, concluding with 2 teams left on 18 to determine the overall Champions. In the event of a tie on any of the holes a chip-off will determine which teams advance. **USGA Rules will govern all play.**
